ORDINANCE #088

May 18, 2016

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THAT THE TWO QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR THE VACANT POSITIONS ON THE 2016 ELECTION BALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND ARE THEREFORE ELECTED TO THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN.

Whereas, three positions on the Board of Aldermen were to be filled during the May 7, 2016 election; and

Whereas, two qualified citizens filed for two of these positions on the ballot for the May 7, 2016 election; and

Whereas, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas has furnished written certification of the unopposed status of the two qualified citizens that filed for a position on the May 2016 election ballot, and

Whereas, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a) authorizes the Board of Aldermen of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals or is less than the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS THAT:

The two qualified citizens Olan Kelley and Terry Nuss are elected to the positions of Mayor and Alderman, respectively, in the City of Highland Haven, Texas effective May 18, 2016.

PASSED AND APPROVED this the *19th day of April 2016* by a yes vote of 5 and a no vote of 0.
