

**CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS
ORDINANCE #094**

May 15, 2018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS, CERTIFYING THAT THREE QUALIFIED CITIZENS WHO FILED FOR THE VACANT POSITIONS ON THE 2018 ELECTION BALLOT WERE UNOPPOSED AND ARE THEREFORE ELECTED.

Whereas, two positions on the Board of Aldermen were to be filled during the May 5, 2018 election; and

Whereas, two qualified citizens filed for two of these positions on the ballot for the May 5, 2018 election; and

Whereas, one position for Mayor was to be filled during the May 5, 2018 election; and

Whereas, one qualified citizen filed for this position on the ballot for the May 5, 2018 election; and


Whereas, the election official for the City of Highland Haven, Texas has furnished written certification of the unopposed status of the two qualified citizens that filed for a position of Aldermen on the May 2018 election ballot, and that one qualified citizen has filed for a position of Mayor on the May 2018 election ballot; and

Whereas, the Texas Election Code Section §2.053 (a) authorizes the Board of Aldermen and the Mayor of the City of Highland Haven, Texas to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office when the number of qualified citizens filing for a position on the ballot equals or is less than the number of vacancies to be filled.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF HIGHLAND HAVEN, TEXAS THAT:


The two qualified citizens, Don Hagans and Terry Nuss are elected to the positions of Aldermen for two years, and, Olan Kelley is elected to the position of Mayor for two years in the City of Highland Haven, Texas, effective May 5, 2018.
